

- **Preface:**

The rules and regulations laid down by the AICTE stipulate that all institutions established by Society and coming under the preview of the council are required to constitute the Governing Bodies and its committees for managing the affairs of the institutions.



## **Mechanism / Norms & Procedure For Democratic/ Good Governance**

- **Constitution of the Governing Body:**

The governing body of an Institution shall have equal representation from the Society on the one hand and the Government, Council and Affiliating Body on the other hand. The Principal of the Institution shall be the Member-Secretary of the Governing Body. The constitution is so prescribed that the collective wisdom of the members of the society, Government officials, officials of the affiliating body and the expert members is available for smooth running of the institution. The Governing Body constitutes of 14 members including the Chairman and Member Secretary. The registered Society shall nominate 6 members including the Chairman and the Member Secretary and the 8 members shall be nominated as indicated below.

- **Governance System :**

The institute is governed by “AICTE, New Delhi”, “DTE, Mumbai”, “Govt. of Maharashtra” and affiliated to “MSBTE, Mumbai”.

- **Appointment of the Chairman of Governing Body:**

The Chairman of the Governing Body shall preferably be a technical person either an entrepreneur or an industrialist of repute who is interested in the development of technical education, member of the parent Society and has demonstrated an interest in promotion of quality education.

- **Functions of the Governing Body:**

The Governing Body is responsible for the management of the Institution. Its function shall include the following:

- To form the following Sub-Committees and consider the recommendations made by them:
  1. Finance Committee
  2. Equipment Committee
  3. Building Committee
  4. Staff Selection Committee
- To approve the budget estimates- recurring and non- recurring for the financial year in advance.
- To scrutinize and accept the audited statement of account for each year.
- To estimate the workload, approve the staff requirement for teaching and non-teaching (technical and administrative) for the Institute.
- To consider and approve the proposals for creation of infrastructure such as building,

equipment, library on continuous basis.

- To consider and make provisions for meeting the general and specific conditions laid by the Council (AICTE), the State Government and Affiliating Body and monitor the progress in fulfilling the conditions.
- To consider the report of the Principal on status of admission.
- To consider the report of the Principal on the academic performance of the students.
- To supervise the observance of service conditions of the Staff as prescribed by the Affiliating Body/ Government.
- To consider the proposals of the Principal for improvement in academic performance of the Staff.
- To consider any other matter in so far as it enhances the academic atmosphere in the Institution.
- To consider any proposal for expansion of educational activities to be made to the Council/Government/Affiliating Body.


#### **Students Feedback on Institutional Governance / Faculty Performance**





The Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education has adopted the policy of designing the curriculum based on the scientific principles since 1995.

- As a part of curriculum implementation, the student assessment norms have been implemented.
- The curriculum mainly focuses on professional and generic skill development in students and meeting the desired quality of teaching, learning and management. This needs redesign of whole education process and to plan the activities at various levels such as institution, department, and teacher level on regular basis.
- The Heads of Institutions are required to perform various functions to manage the change along with their routine activities.
- The Curriculum Implementation and Assessment Norms (CIAAN) are prepared for ensuring the effective curriculum implementation.
- The norms are focused on the progressive assessment of the student. However, this also provides feedback at regular intervals to the teachers.
- This will also be helpful to the institutions to manage the resources effectively and efficiently.
- It is expected that this will bring uniformity in the curriculum implementation and student assessment to meet the objectives.

## **Approach for Curriculum Implementation**

The MSBTE has designed its curriculum by adopting Systems Approach. The same approach has been considered while considering Curriculum Implementation. The salient features from the diagram are as follows. The customer of the system is industry and community that requires competent technical manpower. In order to produce the desired output, curriculum implementation process should be well planned and executed. The diagram shows sequential learning process, from state level planning to students' meaningful learning. To carry out the educational processes, the enabling processes have been identified as shown in the diagram. To ensure effective curriculum implementation, the management structure has been proposed under the control of MSBTE such as RBTE, RCC, ICIU, EAMC and IAMC. The mechanism proposed will ensure the quality of the processes. This will be achieved through the monitoring carried out by EAMC and IAMC. The diagram shows the output of this process. In order to ensure improvement in Teaching-learning process and quality of output, the systems approach is most appropriate.
